



New Medicare cards have no Social Security number on them. New cards aimed at reducing identity theft among seniors.

NEW CARDS HAVE STARTED TO ARRIVE TO WV SENIORS.

The new number is 11-characters in length and made up only of numbers and uppercase letters (no special characters). Each one is unique, randomly generated and the characters are "non-intelligent," which means they don't have any hidden or special meaning.

Make sure your mailing address is up to date. If it needs to be corrected, contact Social Security at ssa.gov/myaccount or 1-800-772-1213. Beware of anyone who contacts you about your new

Medicare card. The Social Security Administration will never ask for personal or private information to provide your new Medicare number and card. There have been reports that scammers are calling Medicare recipients and telling them they must pay for the new card. They ask for their checking account and Medicare card numbers. If you receive one of these calls, don't divulge any of that information - hang up. The CMS would never call and ask for payment for a card.

Understand that mailing everyone a new card will take some time. Your card might arrive at a different time than your friend's or neighbor's. Bring your new card to all healthcare appointments.

SENIOR NUTRITION MISSION PROGRAM A program for Harrison County seniors age 60 or older with income at or below 130% of the federal poverty level. For a one person household this would be \$1316 a month or less, and for a two person household this would be \$1784 or less. Call for more information on larger household sizes.

A monthly food box includes 4 cans of vegetables, 2 cans of fruit, 2 cartons of shelf-stable milk, 2 bottles of juice, 2 boxes of cereal, 2 cans of meat, 1 jar of peanut butter, 2 bags of pasta, and a 2 lb. block of cheese. 

RUN FOR YOUR BOARD

Board of Directors Election for the 1/1/2019-12/31/2020 Term (2 years)

The HCSCC Board of Directors will be holding an election for three positions on the Board during October 2018. All members who are in good standing and have been a member of HCSCC, which includes Satellites, for at least one year are eligible to run as a candidate for the Board of Director's Membership Representative Seat.

As stipulated in the HCSCC bylaws, each applicant is required to complete an essay of 150 words or less, stating why he or she would like to be elected as a HCSCC Board of Director's Representative. All candidates will have their picture taken at the HCSCC office to accompany their application.

All applications must be returned to the Center by 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 16, 2018. Applications will be opened by the HCSCC Board of Directors Executive Committee by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, August 17, 2018.

The Executive Committee will review and approve all eligible applications. A ballot of eligible candidates will be prepared and presented to the Board of Directors at the Wednesday, August 22, regular meeting for final approval and publication. The President of the Board of Directors will notify each eligible candidate of application approval within 48 to 72 hours of the August 22 Board meeting.

Candidate names will appear in alphabetical order on the ballot. All qualified nominations will be published in the September and October 2018 newsletters.

Any candidate may withdraw his or her name up to 48 hours prior to the election by notifying the President of the Board of Directors in writing of his or her request to withdraw from the HCSCC election process.
