Banners will be printed and displayed throughout the downtown area beginning mid-June through July 4<sup>th</sup> and late October through Veteran's Day. Once the banners are removed, they will be returned to the individual that purchased the banner.

To participate, complete the application below and return it along with your payment to "The City of Clarksburg" no later than May 15, 2022. Payments may be dropped off to the City Clerk's Office or mailed to Clarksburg City Clerk, 222 West Main Street, Clarksburg, WV 26301. The cost to adopt a banner is \$30.00.
